

Clothing (Casual/General)

- Business Casual Clothes (*0-1 outfits*)
Some tracks do not require a Business Casual Outfit
Gentlemen: Dress shirt/sweater or polo, dress pants
Ladies: Dress shirt/sweater or polo, dress pants or skirt
- Business Formal Clothes (*1-2 outfits*)
Gentlemen: Business suit; collared, button-up shirt and tie/bowtie with dress pants
Ladies: Dress; or dress shirt/blouse and dress pants/skirt
- Dress shoes – Required for both Business Formal and Business Casual

Toiletries

- Bath Towel
- Washcloth
- Body Wash
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Hand Soap
- Hand Towel
- Comb/Brush
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Floss
- Deodorant
- Flip Flops (*suggested for the shower*)

Bedding

- Pillow
- Sleeping bag OR Blankets/sheets

Supplies

- Bible
- Pens/pencils
- Notebook
- Reusable Water Bottle
- Umbrella

Games/Entertainment (*optional*)

- Sports Equipment (basketball, volleyball, soccer ball, tennis racquet and balls, Spike ball, etc.)
- Board Games
- Cards/Card Games
- Musical Instruments

Optional Supplies

- Cell Phone (for limited use) and charger
- Spending Money
- Backpack/Bag (to carry camp binder)
- Snacks
- Medication
